Come prepared with your proof of insurance (see below) and SBDA - if you come without them you won't get passed!

Boat Insurance

Make sure RA Carters knows that you are a Cotswold Waterski Club Member to ensure you get the best price.

You are reminded that under club rules you must have your membership extended to cover up to 4 skiers, 4 kneeboarders, 4 people on rings, 6 people on a banana.

It is also worth noting that if you want to use the single use lake without an observer you should ask for them to cover it - there is no extra charge for this.

Tidy up your plot

You are reminded that you are responsible for keeping the area around your caravan tidy. That includes -

- Tidying up any plants or bushes that have become over grown
- Cutting grass
- Keeping your decking/paving safely maintained (if you have unsafe decking the committee WILL take action)

Skip
