### Club Week

### New Take-off Jetty

A new take-off jetty was delivered last week. Before club week it should be installed in a new position next to the bund. Once it is in place you will need to drive to the jetty in your boat, moor up and unload you skiers onto it.

### Single Use Lake

With the busiest bit of the year in full swing this seems like a good opportunity to remind everyone about how the single use lake (slalom course) booking system works.

At weekends and during club week you need to book a timed slot if you want to ski on course.

- Slots are 10 minutes (not 6 passes – if you fall you'll probably only get 4 passes!)
- Slots can be booked from 6am until 6pm by putting your name on the booking sheet.
- You can only book one slot for yourself at a time – you can't book a second slot until you've used your first slot.
- You can book slots for up to 3 people at a time.
- The booking sheet can be found next to the slalom course jetties.
- Be ready to ski – your slot starts when the previous person finishes NOT when you actually start skiing.

### Bar Licensing Times & Noise

Now we have neighbours near the club house who do like to complain, we need to ensure we close the bar on time and keep the noise levels down as much as possible.

- Please cooperate with Colin when he stops serving and asks you to drink up.
- Please keep the noise down when you are outside the club house.

### Dogs

Please remember that dogs should be on their leads at ALL times when on site. Bags for picking up dog mess can be found in the signing-in hut. If you can't find any ask Avril. There is a bin next to the slalom jetties where you can deposit used bags.

### SBDA

Anyone wishing to take their SBDA (Boat Driving Test) can find the manual on the club website.

### Drop-off Area

Please use the drop-off area properly! Boats should NOT drive inside the buoys, please STAY lake side of the White Danger marker Buoy. You skiers are supposed to swim to the bank and get out rather than have you pick them up!
