NEW BUOYS - You may have noticed that new buoys have been placed in the lake.

The entrance to the drop-off area is now clearly marked. The boat driver should keep these on their right as they pass the drop-off area allowing the skier to ski towards the beach and release the rope. The boat should not go back and pick up the skier, doing so prevents other skiers from dropping off.

Buoys have also been placed to mark the 'No Wake' area in front of the boat jetties.
